



NOTICE OF RACE

McDONALD MARINE 420 VICTORIAN STATE CHAMPIONSHIPS 2009

**(being held in conjunction with the
OAMPS Insurance Brokers Victorian Youth Championships2009)**

The Notice of Race for the OAMPS Insurance Brokers Victorian Youth Championships2009 as posted by Yachting Victoria is applicable to the McDonald Marine 420 Victorian State Championship 2009, except as amended below:

1. SPECIAL NOTES

Boats wanting to compete in the 420 Victorian State Championships 2009 must register separately on the application form provided herein. In addition any boat competing in the 420 Victorian State Championships 2009 must also be a current and financial member of the Victorian 420 Association, that application form is also attached.

2. ENTRY FEE

The entry fee for the 420 Victorian State Championships is separate from the OAMPS Regatta fee required to be paid in the NOR.

Entries for the 420 Victorian State Championships 2009 will be received by the Victorian 420 Association up to 1000hrs on April 18, 2009.

3. SCORING

- a) The Low Point scoring system, Appendix A.4.1 will apply.
- b) Three (3) races are required to be completed to constitute a series.
- c) If only three races have been completed, a boat's series score will be the total of her race scores.
- d) When four (4) or more races have been completed, a boat's series score will be the total of her race scores excluding her worst score.

4. PRIZES

There will be three (4) categories competed for, they are;

Open Class (all sailors)

Prizes will be awarded for 1st, 2nd and 3rd place getters. The first place will also be awarded the Open Class Perpetual Trophy.

Youth Class (Under 19 yrs at 31st December 2009)

Prize for 1st place only will be awarded for this category. The first place will also be awarded the Open Class Perpetual Trophy.

Novice (never raced as a team in a 420 class regatta prior to this event)

1st place only will be awarded for this category.

Ladies (all Female Competitors)

Prize for 1st place only will be awarded for this category. The first place will also be awarded the Ladies Class Perpetual Trophy.

Presidents Endeavour Award

This will only be awarded at the discretion of the President of the Victorian 420 Association.

Note – Perpetual Trophies will only be awarded to the leading boat that is crewed by members of the Victorian International 420 Class Association.

DECLARATION OF PARENT OR GUARDIAN (Must be signed)

The entry of the above boat is conditional on acceptance of the following by the Parents or Guardian of the Competitor(s) racing the boat:

- 1. The race organisers (including ESC, YV and the Victorian International 420 Class Association, their officers, members, servants and agents) shall not be liable for any loss, damage, death or personal injury howsoever caused to the Competitor, his helm or crew as a result of their taking part in the regatta. Moreover, every Parent or Guardian warrants the suitability of the boat entered for the race or races.
- 2. The provision of safety equipment and boats by ESC is neither guarantee that assistance can be rendered to any Competitor in need, nor an acceptance of any responsibility for rescue of competitors. Further, in the event that assistance is rendered to any Competitor, no liability for any loss, damage or injury to the Competitor and/or the boat and its equipment is accepted by either the Club or the crew of such rescue craft.
- 3. RRS Fundamental Rule 4: A boat is solely responsible for deciding whether or not to start or continue racing.
- 4. Agree to be bound by the Racing Rules of Sailing and by all other rules that govern this event.
- 5. I hold and will produce a current measurement certificate for the above boat and membership of an International 420 Class Association in order to qualify as an entry.
- 6. I declare that I hold a valid certificate of insurance which also covers the boat and its crew whilst racing (including Third Party liability cover of at least \$AUD 5,000,000) and which will be valid for the duration of the event.
I have read the above conditions and accept the responsibilities contained therein.
